Medical attendance is provided by local General Practitioners. Residents can continue with their own doctor should they move within the immediate area.

A Chiropodist visits every 3 months and a visiting Dentist and Optician provide annual 'check-ups', although additional visits are arranged to suit individual needs. Also on hand are a Hairdresser and Aromatherapist, who all visit once a week.

Activities

Stimulation and relaxation are very important parts of the care we offer. We focus on a balance of individual, one-to-one and group activities. These include topical discussions based on newspaper readings, music and dancing, arts and crafts, stimulating indoor activity, walking and visits to local tourist and historical centres.
